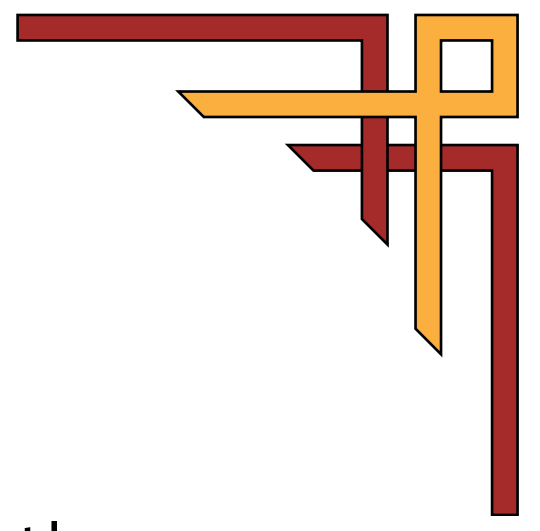
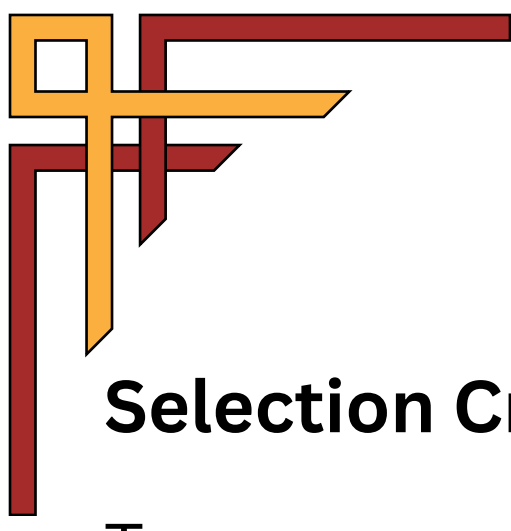

Selection Criteria and Nomination Process for the Award:

To ensure a fair and thorough selection process for this award, the following guidelines have been established:

Nomination Process:

Nominations can be made by anyone with the necessary supporting evidence. Self-nominations are also acceptable.

Eligibility Criteria:

The nominee must be of Tamil descent and a resident of Colorado, USA.

The current Board members of Kurinji Muthamizh Sangam are deemed ineligible due to potential conflicts of interest, given their role in selecting the award recipient.

Impact and Contribution:

The nominee should have a proven track record of community service and support for various social causes, showcasing qualities of dedication and positive impact.

The nominee must have significantly improved the lives of community members, fostering happiness, well-being, and progress.

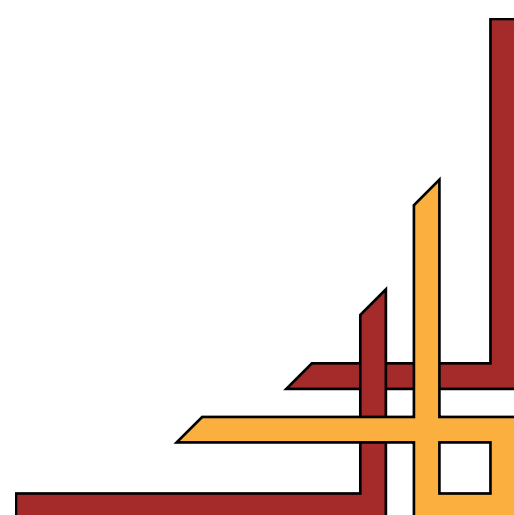
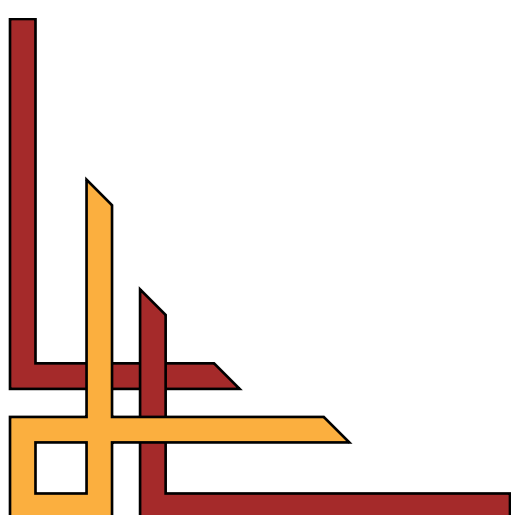
The nominee should have actively addressed community issues, leading to positive change and dedicated substantial time and effort to enhancing the community.

The nominee could be an accomplished scholar, achiever in any field, or a role model who has inspired others.

Nominees need not fulfill all the criteria mentioned above.

Selection Process:

The board will collate testimonials and references from community stakeholders, organizations, or beneficiaries to evaluate the nominee's contributions. A transparent voting procedure among board members will be employed to select the winner(s), ensuring adherence to nonprofit values and upholding integrity. The nomination details and the winner(s) will be shared with the Kurinji Muthamizh Sangam leadership team for their awareness and input; nevertheless, the board retains the final decision-making authority.

Formal notifications will be sent to the winners, inviting them to attend the Kurinji Annual Day event to receive the award.

Additionally, we extend invitations to Mr. Cecil Sunder and/or his sons as distinguished guests for our annual event to partake in the award presentation. In the event that family members are unable to attend, they can access information regarding the winner(s) from our website or request the board members.

Award Details:

A personalized trophy will be presented to a maximum of two deserving individuals annually.

Details of winners will be updated on our sangam website.

Additional Information:

The board retains the prerogative to postpone a meritorious nomination for evaluation in the subsequent year's selection cycle.

This award has been instituted with the approval of Mr. Cecil Sunder. Once granted, this consent, conveyed through email, is irrevocable by either Mr. Sunder or his family members.

The award is slated to be conferred for a minimum duration of 5 years, during which even the Board of Directors of Kurinji Muthamizh Sangam lack the authority to terminate the award.
